Please try to use the same device for the test call as you will use for the appointment.






- 1. Safari on Mac Computers and iPhones and use Google Chrome on all other computers/smart phone If you don't already have Google Chrome, do a web search for 'install chrome' and you will be directed to the correct version for your computer. There is no cost to download.
- 2. Type into search bar www.djhs.org.au/patients-visitors/telehealth
- Press Test call button.
- 4. Press Start test to test your device

On the day – Around the time of your booked appointment

- 2. Start video call and follow the prompts
- 3. Select the name of your clinic specialty from the drop
- 4. Enter your name, and a phone number so we can contact you on at the time of the appointment if we need to (we normally don't need to call you).
- 5. You are then in the online waiting room this is like being in the waiting room at Djerriwarrh Health Services.
- 6. We will then pick up your call when we are ready to start the appointment.

Note: your internet data is not being used until we start the call with you.
